## **Position Overview**

- Lead and supervise a small group of high school students through a group project
- Create and deliver a presentation(s) on relevant topics
- Assist in icebreaker activities, morning and afternoon debriefs, etc.
- Recruit student participants through your networks
- Other duties as assigned

  - Tuesday, July 9, 2024, from 8 am 4 pm
  - Wednesday, July 10, 2024, from 9 am 4 pm
  - Thursday, July 11, 2024, from 9 am 4:30 pm
  - There will also be prep days prior to the start of the program, held either in-person or via Zoom.
  - There will be an in-person debrief session sometime after the end of the program.
